- 2 launcher/receiver assemblies have been included to accommodate inline-inspections
- Parallel to Coastal Gas Link for 181 km or 70% of the route
- Parallel to other facilities for 47 km (includes 41 km Spectra) Caribou area 52 km Freehold land 13 km
- Q1 2016 expected Construction start
