#### 4. **Delegations and/or Presentations**

4 (a) Neil Milne & Ian McLeod, Prince **Rupert Gas** Transmission Project – Status of Project and Upcoming

**Plans** 6850.50.01

Neil Milne and Ian McLeod provided an update on the proposed TransCanada Prince Rupert Gas Transmission Project, a pipeline from the Peace Region (north of Hudson's Hope) to Port Edward on the coast. determination of the route will be made by the end of the summer in 2013 however Mr. Milne advised that the pipeline will not go through the Pine Pass. Council expressed concerns regarding how close the route will come to Cameron Lake. Mr. Milne did not think it was close but agreed to verify.

TransCanada is currently conducting extensive environmental studies; their goal is to mitigate issues before they arise. The company usually tries to follow existing disturbances in the land (i.e. route around sensitive areas such as marsh or drill under lakes/rivers). Approximately 150 feet of right-of-way is required for pipeline construction. Once completed, only about 40 feet of right-of-way is needed, thereby leaving a minimal footprint. Compressor stations are located in remote locations. The pipeline is for gas only.

Approximately 11 – 13 camps housing 600 – 1000 people will be required for the entire project. The camps are contracted out but are monitored by TransCanada. TransCanada works with local communities to minimize the stress on local infrastructure, leaves upgraded roads for local use, sometimes donates camp infrastructure to the community and is committed reclamation programs for a minimum of five years. TransCanada does its best to employ and build skills in the local workforce. The company is interested in the long-term and hopes that communities will see the project as a gain.

Mr. Milne and Mr. McLeod responded to various questions from Council regarding the number and location of compressor stations, the use of existing rights-of-way, the number of proposed transmission lines and the potential for earthquake damage. Clarification was also provided regarding directional drilling beneath rivers and lakes.

Rene Poulin and Julie Shaw provided an update on the Chetwynd Community Gardens and Greenhouses including a history of the project since its inception in 2007.

Plans for 2013 and 2014 include:

- Water project installation
- Investigation and installation of electrical supply for greenhouses
- Planting of potatoes by Little Prairie Elementary School
- Pumpkin growing contest
- Fencing around gardens
- Completion of access to gardens
- Building of dugouts for water supply
- Cultivation and planting of shelterbelts
- Application for Farm Credit Corporation Grant, hopefully receiving it in 2014
- Have two greenhouses on site (Community Garden and Little Prairie Elementary School)
- Creation of composting area.

Mr. Poulin reviewed the conceptual plans for the various phases of the project and noted they are still involved in the local Farmers' Market, Farm to School Program, Community Kitchen and a production facility for locally grown food. The Healing Garden produces and sells \$1,000 - \$2,000 worth of produce per year. It was noted that anyone can rent a 25' X 25' plot at the Community Garden; there is currently no charge for plots and users can grow crops for their own use.
