D-1 Tony Hardy, CN Rail re: Update 0510.20.05 Tony Hardy, CN Rail provided Council with a brief presentation as below:

- 2-4 trains per day go through Chetwynd; 100 150 cars per train (up to two miles long); the trains will get longer as they start to haul rock; two miles is the maximum length allowed
- The timing of the trains all depends on what time they get out of Prince George; the train traffic has been different every day
- All cars should have reflectors on the sides
- Speed limit is 25 mph on main track and decreases down to 10 mph in town
- Train can only block crossings up to a maximum of 15 minutes and can be disconnected in the event of an emergency
- In the event of an emergency, the 1800 number posted at crossings should be called
- Three people are always working on any given train and they will split the train for emergencies; this takes approximately 10 minutes
- Work on Tumbler Ridge Subdivision line is expected to begin in April with an expected completion in September 2017
