4. Delegations and/or Presentations

D-1 Leo Sabulsky, Fire Chief re: 911 Dispatch 7150.01 Leo Sabulsky, District of Chetwynd Fire Chief provided a brief presentation regarding 911 dispatch service in the Peace region as outlined below:

- Currently dispatch service is handled by the Dawson Creek Fire Department (South Peace Fire Dispatch) but their contract is expiring next year and they have not submitted a bid to continue providing service
- The PRRD has confirmed that it has received three proposals for provision of Secondary Safety Answer Point Fire Dispatch Service; North Island 911 Corporation based out of Courtenay, E-Comm 9-1-1 based out of downtown Vancouver and Fort St. John Fire based out of Fort St. John
- South Peace Dispatch answers an average of 700 calls per year; about 100 for Chetwynd Fire Hall
- The Fire Chiefs of the Peace recommend that close attention be given to the negotiations and that Fort St. John be considered as a reasonable and correct choice

D-2 Mark Bartkoski, Conuma Coal Resources re: Brule, Wolverine and Willow Creek Coal Mines 6850.40.02 Mark Bartkoski and Al Kangas, Conuma Coal Resources Limited provided a PowerPoint presentation outlining projections for Conuma Coal Resources Limited as outlined below:

- Conuma Coal is a stand alone Canadian company; affiliated to ERP Compliant Fuels only via "founding common owners"
- Have purchased Walter Energy Canada holdings effective September 9, 2016
- The corporate headquarters will be in Vancouver, BC; will have an office in Tumbler Ridge
- Will be contract miners for Walter Energy until permits transfer; this will allow them to commence operations and hire workforce more quickly
- Brule Mine is anticipated to be at full production by January 2017; trucking of coal will start on the public road route; first train scheduled for mid October 2016, and it is anticipated that they will ramp up to 4 trains per week by February 2017
- Job advertisements are posted; looking for long term employees
- Wolverine Mine will be scheduled for start up in 2017
