D-1 Alan Bone, Sander Rose Grindle LLP re: 2017 Financial Statements 1830.02 Alan Bone, Sander Rose Bone Grindle LLP presented the Consolidated Financial Statements including the Independent Auditor's Report for the year ended December 31, 2017. Noting that, except for the failure to fully adopt Section PS 3260, Liability for Contaminated Sites, of the Public Sector Accounting Board handbook, it was a clean audit, Mr. Bone congratulated all involved.

Council received the Consolidated Financial Statements for the year ended December 31, 2017 and thanked Mr. Bone for the presentation.

D-2 Leo Sabulsky, Chetwynd Communication Society

Leo Sabulsky, Chetwynd Communication Society announced that they have negotiated an agreement with TELUS and with Rogers to vacate and to cease complete usage of the TV Channel Band in order that TELUS and Rogers have full, complete and exclusive use of the channel themselves.

The Society requested that the two companies purchase the necessary equipment to broadcast 10 (ten) digital channels from Wabi Tower, plus complete the engineer's report to the CRTC and Industry Canada.

Rogers and TELUS have agreed to the request and will pay \$34,322 each for the components and the engineered briefs. Their engineers have already designed the systems that they will purchase.

The Society will replace the analog receivers and transmitters by September 1st, 2018 for a total cost of \$17,500.

The Chetwynd Communications Society will meet to consider ratifying this agreement on Wednesday, June 20, 2018.

Council thanked Mr. Sabulsky for the announcement.
